We'll begin our adventure at the **John Deere Tractor Assembly Works** to watch a tractor being built start to finish. This producer of farm equipment is a highly recognized American brand name that has capitalized on its popularity. Don't forget to stop by the John Deere gift shop before we depart. From framed art to die cast miniatures, there is a John Deere version of nearly everything.



Next, it's already **lunch** time, and we're in for a treat at the luxurious Brown Bottle. Located in the Grand Lobby of the Historical Russell Lamson Building, the Brown Bottle has been a dining tradition since 1972. Family owned and operated for 3 generations this unique setting will provide a memorable dining experience.



After lunch, we'll move on to the **Sullivan Brothers Iowa Veterans Museum**. The Museum is named after the five Sullivan brothers from Waterloo, IA. They lost their lives, along with 700 other crewmembers, when their ship, the USS Juneau, was sunk in the South Pacific on November 13, 1942 in the Battle of Guadalcanal. Iowa veterans have a million stories to tell. Did you know that for 150 years, Iowa men and women have preserved the union and safeguarded democracy in numbers proportionately larger than most states – this proud tradition continues yet today. View a brief **video** called "Life & Times of Waterloo's Five Sullivan Brothers" prior to a **guided tour** of the museum. After our tour, we'll have a very special performance by a **WWI re-enactor**, outfitted in official gear and sharing a first person narrative. This experience is sure to make your Veterans Day moving and memorable.



We'll end the day with **beverage and dessert**, at **Barn Happy**. Enjoy the relaxing atmosphere of a charming old dairy barn built in 1925. Barn Happy specializes in Iowa products and proudly feature antiques, primitives, unique locally-made crafts, brown eggs, fresh milk, produce and flowers in season – all reflecting the heart of the heartland.
